\*Public Comment – Each speaker will be allowed a maximum of three (3) minutes and cannot cede their time to another speaker. Each speaker must be recognized by the Mayor as having the exclusive right to be heard. After the citizen has made his or her prepared remarks, he or she will be seated with no further debate, dialogue or comment. The Town Council will not take action on an item that is presented during Public Comment. The time allotted for each session of Public Comment will be 15 minutes. The Board can choose to extend the time for public comment, by a majority vote, an additional 15 minutes; for a maximum time limit of 30 minutes each session for public comments. Persons waiting to publicly address the Governing Body may request to do so by registering prior to the regular monthly meeting with the Town Clerk by calling 454-1138 before 5:00 pm, or at the meeting site 15 minutes prior to the start of the meeting.
