Council Member Montgomery made a motion to go into closed session to consult with the Town Attorney regarding judicial action. Council Member Nixon-Roney made a second to the motion. The motion passed by unanimous vote.

The Town Attorney updated the Council on an alleged ordinance violation case within the city limits of Jamestown. The alleged violation consists of a business located in an improper zoning district.
