# *Jamestown* Parkscape Sponsorship Program

## GUIDELINES

The selection and location of items will be determined in consultation with the Town Manager and/or Town Planner. Donated items will become Town property with maintenance responsibility by the Town until such a time the item requires replacement.

## REMOVAL, RELOCATION, REPLACEMENT

The Town reserves the right to remove and relocate donated items and their associated donation acknowledgments/memorial plaques, when they interfere with safety, maintenance or construction activities. The Town will attempt to contact each identifiable donor notifying the donor of any action related to the disposition of the donated item. In certain situations, such as safety or emergency situations, the notification may be made after the action is taken. In the event a donated item must be permanently removed, the Town will seek an alternative location consistent with this policy. If no such location can be found, the information contained on the memorial may be, at the donor's request, located on a memorial plaque set aside for this purpose at a designated location. When the item requires replacement, Town staff will attempt to contact the donor to provide the opportunity to sponsor the new item. However, if efforts to contact the donor fail, then another donor will be allowed to sponsor the replacement item.

## ONCE YOU HAVE CHOSEN THE GIFT

1. Submit an application to Town Hall.
2. You will be contacted by a member of Town staff to determine the gift's location and expected installation timeline.
3. Upon receipt of payment, Town staff will record your order for the gift. Payment can not be refundable once the order for your item is placed.
4. Town staff will contact the donor when the item is received to discuss the installation timeline.

## MEMORIAL BENCHES

Why limit your message as a memorial? This bench has two back boards for an impressive message to be displayed. The traditional style park bench comes in 6 feet and 8 feet lengths. This cost includes a two-line message with color inlay for visibility. Benches at Jamestown Park will be green with a white inlay for visibility. See price list.



## COMMEMORATIVE TREES

A commemorative tree may be placed in honor or memory of a loved one, family, civic club, or business in select locations. The species of trees or shrubs planted will be determined by planting location, tree species compatibility, and the Town's master park plan. Commemorative plaques will be placed on or near the plantings to preserve plant health. Each tree will include a plaque. See price list.



## TABLES & CHAIRS



A commemorative table may be sponsored at Jamestown Park. The table and chair combination are black powder-coated for an attractive appearance and durability. The table will be installed at approved sites in the order requests are received. See price list.

## COMMEMORATIVE BRICKS

A commemorative brick may be placed along the Wrenn Miller Park entrance walkway in honor or in memory of a loved one, in support of business, civic club, or other cause. The Town reserves the right to place bricks in specific locations and to refuse inappropriate or offensive text. Bricks may contain up to 3 lines of text with up to 18 characters per line (including spaces and punctuation). Larger pavers are available and may include graphics provided by the sponsor, such as corporate logos. See price list.
