will unload and dispose of your old appliance at
no charge. Old tires may be taken to the White
Goods Facility. A resident of Guilford County
is allowed to dispose 5 passenger tires for free.
There is a charge of \$.73 after that.

TOWN OF JAMESTOWN REGULAR GARBAGE DAYS & CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Customers paying solid waste and recycling fee
will receive solid waste & curbside recycling by
the Town.

CURBSIDE RECYCLING

Mondays

Weekly pickup for curbside recycling is every
Monday except Christmas Holiday. (When
occurs on Monday) Curbside recycling should
be in clear bags provided by the customer.

SOLID WASTE COLLECTION

Tuesday and Friday

Garbage should be bagged on the curb side by
7:00 a.m. The bags of garbage should not weigh
more than 50 lbs. If the bags weigh more than
50 lbs. they will not be picked up. Cardboard
boxes may also be collected on this date. Please
do not place plastic bottles in the regular
household garbage. Plastic bottles should be
recycled.

YARD WASTE COLLECTION

Wednesday, Thursday –

Days for grass clippings, hedge trimmings,
twigs and leaves bagged in clear plastic bags or
placed in cardboard boxes.

SPECIAL FEES CHARGED:


Appliance Fee \$20.00
Must be paid at Town Hall prior to pick-up.
Residents may take appliances to D. H. Griffin
in Greensboro to avoid pick-up fee.
Residents may also take appliances to the White
Goods Collection Facility at
2138 Bishop Rd., Greensboro to avoid pick-up
fee.

Professional contractors performing any
yard work or construction work will be
responsible for removing any waste.
Contractors doing tree work are responsible for
removing all tree trunks, stumps and limbs. The
debris may be taken to Ingleside Compost
Facility located at 3001 Ingleside Drive, High
Point, NC, 336-883-8514. Fees may apply.

LOOSE LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

Regular loose leaf pick-up will take place from
October until the end of February as advertised.
All other times, the leaves must be in clear bags
or cardboard boxes. Customers must provide
their own clear bags or cardboard boxes.





**YARD WASTE
COLLECTION SCHEDULE
Wednesday and Thursday**

Brush and yard waste will be picked up on Wednesday and Thursday. Brush & yard waste must be at the street by 7:00 am on Wednesday.

Limbs no longer than 6' in length and not to exceed 50 lbs.

LIMB LIMITATIONS – THE CORRECT CUT


Limbs and brush larger than 1 inch in diameter but smaller than 6 inches in diameter must be cut not to exceed 6 feet in length.

Tree trunks and limbs larger than 6 inches in diameter must not exceed 2 feet in length and must not weight more than 50 pounds. Generally, limbs and tree trunks larger than 10 inches are too heavy for collection.

Wood cannot weigh more than 50 lbs. Pre-treated wood will be picked up with the regular trash collection.

Grass clippings, hedge trimmings, twigs and leaves bagged in clear plastic bags or put in cardboard boxes. Cannot weigh more than 50 lbs.

Note: Collections on Wednesday or Thursday may not be made if there is not enough yard waste to justify a pick-up.



RECYCLING

The Recycling Bins located behind the Town Hall have been removed. Recycling will no longer be accepted at this location. For customers inside the city limits of Jamestown, please have your recycling in clear plastic bags placed at your curb by 7:00 am on Mondays. Main St. businesses place recycling at curb on Main St. by 9:00 am on Mondays.
